Communication (Penny Fleming)

<u>Security Patrol – Nighttime Patrol with Seascape</u> (Penny Fleming)

- Penny noted that last year, we had daytime security. This year, because COVID restrictions were lifted, we will not have daytime security. We will have night security, in collaboration with Seascape, to provide security for both communities at a lower cost to the association.
- Question asked on the Zoom regarding getting cell numbers of security to be able to report incidents as they are happening. Penny will ask security and follow up.

<u>Financial Report</u> (Mike Halloran, Finance Committee Chair)

• Mike Halloran noted that the 2021 budget has been approved by the board. It is a balanced budget. Finance committee is anticipating a robust membership. They are also anticipating events this year that did not occur last year to generate revenue as well. Beach clean up... did not need to happen extensively last year due to tides, but is budgeted this year. Security also budgeted for this year. Program expenses also budgeted, which did not occur last year. Bottom line... the finance committee anticipates a slight income of approx \$2000, after debt payment for tennis courts.

- Seaweed... no set schedule but will be removed by a vendor that the association hires.
- Kayak racks. Will be in place, sign up and stickers are the same system as last summer. Members are highly encouraged to sign up ASAP. Non-stickered kayaks will be removed. Kayaks are not allowed on the beach grass at any time.

Beach Committee Report (Sarah Maxwell)

 Sarah noted excitement about having a committee this year. Excited to get back to normal this summer. Committee has met together and met with the guards.
