We are excited for this year's summer and our team of lifeguards for this year. We are currently in the hiring process for lifeguards and beach monitor. As lifeguards return and new lifeguards are hired, we will update the Beach Info webpage on our SBIA Website.

The Beach Staff will kick off the season on June 24! We look forward to a summer of fun activities, including swim lessons, aerobics classes, beach races, and the Horribles Parade.

The more members we have, the quicker we will have the beach ready for safe fun in the sun. We will meet at 9:00 am at the beach at the Ocean View entrance. Workers should bring their gloves. The beach clean-up generally takes a few hours. We will delegate clean-up crews for the beach and dunes, the beach entrances, the courts, and select areas outside the courts. We will also set up the Membership Table so you can pick up your 2023 Membership Cards. (Rain date: June 25). *No sign-up is required.*
- Association Summer Kick-Off and Welcome Party, June 24: This year's summer Welcome Party returns to our NSB Tennis Courts. Join the fun and meet with friends and neighbors to kick off the 2023 summer with a bang! The party starts at 7:00 pm and ends

at about 10:00 pm. We will have a cash "wine and beer" bar, appetizers, and dessert platters provided by the Adult Activities & Events Committee. *No sign-up is required.* 

• SBIA Senior Pickleball (55 and up) beginning June 25: It's hard to believe that we are going into our seventh year of pickleball in New Silver Beach (the fastest-growing sport in the country!). Pickleball is a fun paddle sport that combines tennis, badminton, and pingpong elements. - NSB Gets Fit! beginning June 26: Our ever-popular boot camp-style fitness program is back for the NINTH year! Our NSB fitness program meets three times a week on Monday, Wednesday, and Friday from 8:00 am to 9:00 am at the NSB Tennis Courts (and sometimes on the beach!). • SBIA Sunday Night at the Movies beginning July 2: Each Sunday at Sunset, bring your blanket and pillow to the NSB Tennis Courts to watch a kid's movie with your friends. - Kids' Tennis Clinics beginning July 11: Peter Walter is back to teach the NSB tennis clinics! The NSB junior tennis program serves players from 4 to 12 years of age. The clinics are designed for 12 and under; balls bounce lower, don't move as fast through the air, and are easier to hit. Racquets are sized for small hands, and the court area is smaller and easier to cover. In a short time, kids are rallying, playing, and excited to keep playing. That means kids will have more fun and less frustration. Parents need to sign their children up for age-appropriate classes. Complete the Kids Tennis Clinic Registration Form. ### **Beach and Other New Silver Beach Information**


- **Beach Rules** (*printable copy included*): Please <u>**post these rules**</u> at your home for your family, guests, and renters to see. The rules aim to ensure everyone's safety, including emergency and safety signals, and for the preservation of the beach. These rules will be monitored and enforced.
- Membership Cards: We will again hand out membership cards early in the summer. You can pick up your membership cards during regular business hours at the JW NSB Store or at the Membership Tables (volunteers are needed to staff tables, to volunteer, complete the <u>SBIA Activities Volunteer Sign-up Form</u>) at the beach entrances on most weekends and during activities and events. Please bring your card to the beach and activities and make them available for guests and renters. Beach monitor(s) and Board Members will randomly check membership cards.
- **Tennis Court Recommendations:** The Tennis Court area is for the use and pleasure of all our Association Members and their guests. They are open at 8:00 am each day and close at dusk. As has been recommended by our Tennis Court installer, there will be no rollerblades, skateboards, or bicycles on the court's surface. Asphalt is softer than concrete and permanent damage can occur. Please keep our Tennis Courts beautiful for everyone's use!
- **Dunes at Tennis Court:** Please do not put boats or kayaks on the dunes beside the kayak rack. This is an environmental concern aimed at protecting the dunes.
- Joanne Ward New Silver Beach Store (JW NSB Store): The JW NSB Store team has been working over the winter to prepare for the new summer season. We have many unique items that we hope you will enjoy! # Silver Beach Improvement Association BEACH RULES FOR 2023

## **Beach Access & Beach Staff**

- Association beach, lifeguards, raft, and swim lessons are intended for SBIA members, their families, and guests; please display your membership card at the beach.
- Lifeguards are on duty from June 25th through August 21st.
- 9:00 am to 5:00 pm daily or as posted.
- Swimming lessons, Monday through Friday; <u>CLICK HERE</u> to sign-up online.

## Water Safety Guidelines

### (any issues, please alert the Lifeguards)

- Emergency Signals
  - **ONE LONG WHISTLE ATTENTION**
  - $\circ$   $\;$  TWO LONG WHISTLES CLEAR THE WATER IMMEDIATELY!
- Flotation devices are prohibited on and accessing the raft.
- No pushing on the raft, no swimming under the raft, and no diving off the raft.
- Paddleboards, kayaks, windsurfers, etc., should be launched at the fishing jetty and are not permitted within the swim area during beach hours.

# **Beach Safety & Cleanliness Guidelines**

### (any issues, please notify the Beach Committee)

- Coolers and food should not be brought onto the beach; they should be left on the wall at the entrances. Picnic tables are available at the courts.
- Alcoholic beverages and coolers are prohibited on the beach.
- Glass containers are prohibited.
- Our beach is a carry-in/carry-out area, and please remove all trash as you leave.
- Beach tents are prohibited.
- The lifeguards reserve the right to ask members and guests to remove or relocate umbrellas.
- Animals are NOT permitted on the beach from May 1 to October 1, per Town of Falmouth beach regulations.
- Smoking and vaping are prohibited.
- Littering is NOT permitted on the beach.

# **Entrance Safety**

- Keep beach entrances clear and accessible for emergency personnel.
- Be mindful of handicapped parking areas and emergency vehicle/fire lane areas designated by the Town of Falmouth.

#### Thank you for being respectful and courteous to your neighbors and our beach!

# **RULES FOR MOSES ROAD BEACH ASSOCIATION**

The SBIA and ownership of the Moses Road Beach Association has agreed upon the following rules:

- 1. The SBIA Beach Rules shall apply, including prohibiting coolers, alcohol, and glass on the beach.
- 2. Members of the Association and their guests may use the beaches, but if asked by one of the owners of the property to give them space, SBIA members and their guests shall comply.
- 3. No parking of SBIA members' or their guests' vehicles on the property, nor blocking owners' access to their parking area at the corner of Moses Road and Ocean View Avenue.
- 4. Please respect the owners of the property and their wishes.

# **RULES FOR WEST AVENUE BEACH**

The SBIA and the Mavrides Family Irrevocable Trust have agreed upon the following rules, which own the beach adjacent to the parking lot/playground (near the harbor).

- 1. Beach Rules similar to those of the SBIA shall apply, including prohibiting coolers and alcohol.
  - Coolers and food should not be brought onto the beach.
  - Alcoholic beverages are prohibited.
  - Glass containers are prohibited.
- 2. Members of the Association and their guests using the beach shall comply if one of the owners asks to give them space.
- 3. No storing of dinghies or small boats on the West Ave beach. Dinghies must be stored at the public Grove Street beach.
- 4. All kayaks must be placed on the racks or taken home, not left on the West Ave beach.
- 5. No one is allowed on the stone seawall or boulders along the property for any reason. There is no access to the front beach along or through the property of the Mavrides Family Trust.

#### IMPORTANT NOTE: The Moses Road Beach Association and Mavrides Family Trust have graciously given the SBIA members access to their private beaches; these rules apply and are not negotiable. If an owner asks you to leave their beach, you will need to find another location.

# Silver Beach Improvement Association TENNIS COURT RECOMMENDATIONS

Our tennis courts are where our activities really start. Our courts are open each morning at 8 am and close at dusk. Children take tennis lessons there, kids meet for friendly get-togethers there in the summer, folks meet to play Pickleball, Tennis, and Basketball, and many of our SBIA events are held on the courts. It's what we had in mind all along, right?

Something you didn't have in mind, though, is what seems to be happening with increased frequency. Members are complaining that folks have had a fast-food picnic overnight and left food wrappers, empty bottles, etc. lying around.

You show up to play and end up having to clean up the mess, and suddenly, you become aware of several other problems. Someone has allowed their children to use one court to ride their collapsible scooters because the surface is marked. On another court, there are permanent black marks because someone has allowed their children to ride their bikes and skateboard.

The same thing that makes our Association courts great — the fact that any member or guest can use them — is the same thing that threatens them: anyone can use them (and, unfortunately, abuse them).

Having just put in the tennis courts and the fact that we are still paying on our loan, it's not possible to hire a security force to keep an eye on our tennis courts. But we, as members of the Silver Beach Improvement Association, should be taking a few proactive measures to try to keep the courts undamaged and safer.

#### Save Our Surface

A tennis court is built with certain traffic in mind, namely court shoes and tennis and pickleballs. It's not set up to accommodate skateboards, inline skates, bikes, scooters, and other uses, and the surface is going to be marked up by basketball shoes, street shoes, and so forth.

Signs have been posted stating the rules (no skates, bikes, etc. on the surface). Unfortunately, that only works for those who read the signs and obey the rules, two ingredients that are often missing from those who are abusing the courts.

#### What Can We Do?

We will continue to lock the gates at night and ask that our nighttime security check the area on their rounds. We are scheduling more activities in the daytime hours to keep the courts busy. Courts that see a lot of player traffic are less likely to sit idle and less likely to be used the wrong way or even abused. We ask our members to be vigilant in keeping skates, bikes, etc., off the surface to protect the courts for future use.
