Opening Remarks

- Board has been planning- now in Phase 2, hopefully moving to Phase 3 soon. Will bring a new group of guidelines.
- Operation based on the health and safety of all members. Will follow the guidelines of the state.
- Managing, not policing guidelines. Will be up to members.
- Sub Committee Plan developed and presented to the board.
- Decisions and changes will be made as we progress through the phases.

Presentation of Summer Plan - Develop by Subcommittee and Approved by the SBIA Board on June 17, 2020:

Guiding Principal and Global Rules

- Health and Safety are top priority
- Follow CDC, state and local guidelines
- Wear a mask when social distancing not possible
- Encourage following of guidelines but will not be responsible for enforcing them
- Reserve the right to change rules as needed based on changing conditions
- Incumbent upon members to follow the rules
- Rules will be posted
- Beach, courts and playground are open to use at YOUR OWN RISK

Beach (Phase 2)

- No groups larger than 10 people
 - Groups must be 6 feet apart from other groups
- Masks worn when social distancing isn't possible
- People exiting have right of way
- Beach games are prohibited
- Suggest bringing a pool noodle to measure distance from neighbors
- Members may not save space

- Please refrain from having guests if possible
- Raft will not be put in at this time- may be put in later- too challenging for lifeguards to manage.
- Stay at home if you have a fever (100.4 or higher) or feel unwell.

Phase 3

• TBD once state releases updated guidelines

Beach Support

- Association has Hired Beach Patrol Kevin Casey
- Will be wearing a lime green shirt while working
- Hours of work: 10am-3pm weekdays, 10-4 weekends
- Responsibilities: Largely social distancing issues, especially in the beginning the Summer
 - Verifying membership
 - Monitoring beach to determine capacity, group size, etc.
 - Assisting members in choosing a safe beach space
 - Helping to de-escalate any arguments or issues that may arise
 - Monitoring group size
 - Carry-In, Carry-Out Trash Policy. No barrels in order to avoid "lidless" recommendation per state guidelines (seagull issue). Keeps lifeguards safe from handling trash.
 - Membership Cards should be visible at the beach. Each family gets one card.
 - Membership cards can be picked up for the next two weekends at the beach entrances (6/20-6/21 and 6/27-6/28 from 10 am to 3 pm) or at Rich McCarthy's house.

Beach Safety Protocols:

- Lifeguards will have temperatures taken and recorded
- Beach Patrol Guard will have temperature taken
- Full PPE for lifeguards
- Training will include practicing on how to handle emergency situations during COVID-19 Era

Swimming Lessons:

• Youngest Classes (Tadpole, Guppy and Minnow) will require a parent or caregiver in the water with them. Four children plus caregiver in each group. Classes will be capped at 12 per class.

- Older classes (Dolphin and Shark) will be placed in groups of nine with one guard. Classes will be capped at 27 per class.
- Swimmers are required to bring their own personal kickboards and pool noodles.

- No planned events until after July 4th, including movies
- Will reassess in July
- Activities and events listed on website
- Horrible Parade cancelled this year for safety reasons

- Tennis lessons have been cancelled for this year
