# Silver Beach Improvement Association



SBIA Member Survey 2019 - Response Analysis

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### **Scope of Survey**

- Survey distributed to all 2018 paid members with at least one email address
  - > 412 household members received survey (22 households we have no email)
  - > 643 total survey pool
- > 309 total responses (completed surveys); 262 households
  - > 48% response rate overall
  - 64% of households emailed the survey responded (represents 60% of membership)
- Members were allowed to submit up to two responses per household
- Survey was open for 15 days
  - Sunday, Feb. 17 Sunday, March 3




### Q1. Overall, how satisfied are you with the efforts of the SBIA to make New Silver Beach a fun and safe community? (Activities, Events, Beach, Community)


## Q2. Do you feel you receive enough benefit/value for the amount of dues you pay?


#### Q3. How satisfied are you with the new courts area?



#### Q4. Do you, or members of your household, use the courts for recreation?






#### Q6. Are there other uses you would like for the courts area?



## Q7. Do you believe there is enough communication throughout the summer about activities, events, etc.?






#### Q9. How satisfied are you with the SBIA Store and how it is managed?


## Q10. How satisfied are you with the beach in general? (Cleanliness, beach rules, safety, etc.)



# Q11. How effective are the lifeguards at ensuring safety and a positive experience at the beach?






# Q13. How satisfied are you with the swim lessons included with your membership?



## Q15. Please rate the below adult activities/events based on the perceived enjoyment it provides you or members of your household.





	rake the beach and remove seaweed on a regular basis; We have a verbal agreement from a primary source and are

	Beach cleanup day (June 22) will focus on cleaning debris from the beach and entrances — please help us prepare
	the beach for summer!; Ongoing cleaning is planned as well, utilizing lifeguards in the morningsand the seaweed
	removal service (referenced above) will also address debris; Trash barrels will be placed at each entrance every
	morning and emptied at the end of each day; Last summer a number of members helped remove glass caused by the
	harbor dredgingthis had a significant positive impact and we encourage your volunteerism again this summer.
Beach cleanliness	Also, this is a great way for students to get volunteer hoursthe board will sign necessary volunteer forms.
	The lifeguards and Beach Committee are tasked with enforcing the beach rules defined by the Board. We also ask
	that you encourage everyine to follow the rules; they are intended to ensure a safe and pleasant beach experience.
	Please post and review the rules which are included within your membership package each year with your guests
Beach management	and/or renters.
	Again this summer we will be setting up membership tables and handing out beach tags; While we can not prevent
	anyone from accessing the water or town property our intent is to encourage non-members living in our
	neighborhood to join the association and to direct "day trippers" and overflow from Old Silver Beach and other areas
Restrict SBIA beach usage to members	to public beaches.
	We are working closely with the Falmouth Police department to ensure they are aware of our needs as a town
	community; They have committed to patrol our neighborhood at night on a regular basis; We will also request/hire
	police details for our busiest nights of the summer; Additionally, we have contracted with a security company to
Night monitoring of beach and	surveil the beach area several times per week. Note the police department's stance is: "if you hear it or see call, call
neighborhood	it". The more calls the department gets the more attention we will get.
	There is no parking area that the SBIA has control of; the entrances to the beach are town property and the changes
	made last year at the Ocean View Ave entrance were done by the Falmouth DPW to ensure there is a designated
	right-of-way to the beach for emergencies; We need to adhere to the town's designations at each beach entrance.

	The association does not have control of the area surrounding the harbor bulkhead, where people frequently park;
	this is town property.
	The Board discussed defining a clear, safe area on our property to allow members to safely access the playground
Parking at the harbor	and "baby beach."
	There are no bathrooms at/near the beach for member use. The port-o-potties at the courts are, as required by law,
	for SBIA employees (lifeguards) and vendors contracted by the association. We do not have the space nor ability to
	manage facilities to support over 400 member households and their guests. As well, we do not want to make it
Bathrooms	easier for non-members from outside our community to utilize SBIA property/assets.
	During the August 2018 association meeting a member raised concern about unleashed dogs roaming the beach (and
	neighborhood). We discussed it briefly then and also addressed it again during the winter Board meeting. The
	Board's position remains that we follow 1) MA order MGL C. 140, §§ 173 and 173A "all dogs shall be restrained
	from running at large, unless said dogs are leashed and accompanied by the owner or keeper or a person authorized
	by said owner or keeper." and 2 )Town of Falmouth Beach Regulations "Animals are NOT permitted on the beach
	or in beach parking lots from May 1 to October 1. This includes leaving pets in parked vehicles. Service dogs required
	because of a disability are permitted." We encourage all dog owners to abide by these rules. As well, it is a public
Dogs on the beach	safety requirement that all dogs are licensed. And, please clean up after your dog.
	We are excited to begin rolling out a new program focused on helping assimilate new members to our neighborhood
	and the association. We are planning to hold Board-led adult and children events early in the summer, with a focus
	on helping new members meet other members and learn about the many activities we hold throughout the summer.
	We will begin detailing these events in forthcoming communications. To our longstanding members, please take the
Welcoming new members	time to welcome your new neighbors and invite them to some of your favorite events.
	Installing a "wall" at the courts was brought up by some, for practicing tennis and pickleball and for showing the
	movies. (And a little bit for nostalgia.) With the new configuration of the courts area there is not adequate room for
	a structure on the court surface, without it encroaching the playing areas. We are researching other options,
	particularly a practice backboard mounted to the fence. Multiple factors are being considered, including: how much
	use it will get for its intended purpose, how to prevent unintended use, visual asthetics, and others. For the movies,
	we believe the portable screen we invested in last summer sufficiently meets our needs.

	Many of you suggested new activities you would like to see held during the summer. Thank you for the
	suggestionswe always want to ensure the events we organize are of interest to you. We are planning to add
	several of your suggestions to the calendar for this summer, including kids' basketball and cornhole tournaments.
	Other great ideas are also being considered; while they might not be listed on the calendar, if we have the volunteers
	to organize them we can add them thoughout the summer. SHAMELESS PLUG: Please consider volunteering to help
New activities	run an event. The more volunteers we have the more events we can run.
	While email is the most preferred channel for receiving association communications, many of you also listed the SBIA
	Website. So we have started taking steps to upgrade the Website, making the content more timely and dynamic.
	Also, some of you listed text messaging; we will begin exploring how that can be enabled. And for those not aware,
	we have a physical message board affixed to the side of the Joanne Ward SBIA Store at the courts, and the lifeguards
Communication channels	regularly update the sandwich boards at the beach entrances.
	While most members are satisfied with the Joanne Ward SBIA Store, some commented that the store is not open
	enough. The hours of operation are limited by the number of volunteers we have. We have a great team of
	volunteers in place now, but the more vounteers we have the more the store can be open. Please consider
SBIA Store hours	volunteering.
	A number of you mentioned the condition of the sea wall to the right as you enter from Ocean View Ave and the jetty
	that forms the channel to the harbor as safety concerns. We agree. Neither is association property, however, we
Safety Seawall and "fishing" jetty	will represent our member interests and encourage these concerns be addressed.
	Speeding on some key neighborhood roads (Silver Beach Ave, Ocen View Ave, to name a few) was raised as another
	safety concern. The Board will continue to represent our interests with the Town. As well, as taxpayers we all have
Safety speeding and golf carts	the opportunity to express our concerns with the Town. The more voices they hear the more attention we will get.
	Great idea, and we will expore the viability of it. The entrances are Town property and we need to honor how they
	have designated those areas. Given that, its a question of whether there is a safe space for a picnic table. Note we
Picnic tables at the beach	do have several picnic tables on our property at the courts, for your use.
	The Beach Committee will continue to define rules to ensure the safety of our beach. And the committee is
	proactively training our guards and reinforcing best practices. Some of note include: guards rotating positions and
	watching the water from different vantage points throughout the day; going out to the raft to watch members more
	closely (partiularly at very high/low tides); actively engaging with members and beach goers; and only one guard on
	the lifeguard stand at a time. And cell phone use is not allowed, unless it it to contact another guard or a Beach
Active lifeguarding	Committee member regarding a situation (or if the guard is on break).
Area to launch	Small craft such as windsurfers, kayaks, canoes, paddle boards can be launched from the far end of the beach,
windsurfers/kayaks/paddle boards	along the "fishing" jetty (the jetty that creates the channel for the harbor).
