## SBIA WINTER BOARD MEETING

March 24, 2018

Called to order at 5:27 pm

- General Update David O'Keefe
  - 1. Courts restoration project
    - a. Status ready to start construction phase (financing approved through Rockland Trust); start date approximately mid-April (demo and trenching done by Mike Pacella prior to start); sub team is looking into details of next steps including permits, electrical, etc.; concerns about project being finished on time: do we take the risk? Need to ask Cape and Islands for their schedule
    - b. Donations/sponsorship program create formal program? Potential to be phase 2 of the tennis court project, but want to consider it at end of summer; sell commemorative bricks and make patio?
  - 2. Security/Details
    - a. Membership tables were very successful last year; group agreed to do membership tables again this summer, on strategic weekends
    - b. Reminder, we can't stop people from accessing the beach;
    - c. Membership tags/visual Agreed we should create and distribute some type visual designation of membership.
    - d. Security/Details police details during the day last summer were not effective, they only left the car to get lunch at the Tea Room; Consider hiring private security? Concerns that security guards span of control is limited because the town doesn't/can't enforce their own laws in our neighborhood. Town says if you have issues "call us"; need to have someone secure the nights around the 4<sup>th</sup>, need to set the tone at the beginning of the summer, bring it up at the Memorial Day meeting, have police liaison come to Memorial Day meeting; Dave doesn't want to commit to security without knowing what the town will enforce
  - 3. Kayak rack process
    - a. New rack is up, but enforcement for removal at the end of the season was an issue
    - b. Want to assign numbers to easily identify kayaks
    - c. Still do a lottery, have a lot of capacity so space shouldn't be a problem
    - d. Spaces for \$25 per rack spot
  - 4. New Silver Beach store
    - a. Julie Rotundo will continue to manage store
    - b. Same hours as last summer, should post on website, send out hours on emails, and keep hours consistent
    - c. Showing a good profit at the end of 2017, so ordered inventory with surplus for 2018 season
  - 5. Vice President vacancy
    - a. Need to make an effort to fill role
      - 1. President can only have 3 consecutive terms, so VP needs to be groomed so s/he is ready to take over after Dave's third year
  - 6. Open
